Context

Words derive meaning from context. I love chocolate, and I love my wife. My desire for chocolate is not as great as my feelings for my wife. Loving chocolate does not mean that I only eat chocolate whereas loving my wife means that we are in an exclusive relationship. Therefore, the word love can mean different things in different settings.

Several biblical words change meaning according to context. One example is the word faith. Depending on the context, it can mean at least five different things. Faith may denote the system of beliefs which God has revealed for all Christians to follow (Jude 1:3). It may signify the miraculous power which God gave to some Christians (1 Corinthians 13:2). It may mean saving faith (Ephesians 2:8). There is also a dead faith (James 2:17). Finally, faith may imply personal convictions (Romans 14:2).

If we are going to understand and apply Scriptures correctly, we must consider the context of the words. If we fail to recognize the context of a word, we may misinterpret God's meaning and misapply His instructions.

Failure to consider context may leave us short of God's will or well beyond it. Context is to biblical interpretation what location is to buying property. Context is to biblical interpretation what gas is to a car. Context is to biblical interpretation what love is to being a Christian (1 John 4:8).
