Purpose of the Church

The church has three primary purposes:

1. **To glorify God.** This is the purpose of all creation
 (Hab. 2:14). This is the reason of His works of
 salvation (Eph. 1:6, 12, 14). God's glory is the
 purpose for your existence (Rom. 9:17; Phil. 2:11;
 Rev. 4:8, 11).
2. **To proclaim God's message of salvation.** This was
 Jesus' purpose (Lk. 4:43; 19:10). This is Jesus'
 command (Lk. 10:1-16; Mk. 16:15). The Holy Spirit
 called men to preach the gospel (Acts 13:2, 48-49).
3. **To keep the saved saved.** We are to encourage
 spiritual maturity in Christ (Rom. 14:19; Eph. 4:11-
 15; Col. 1:24).

As we evaluate 2023 and plan for 2024, let's remember
 God's purpose for the church of Christ and ask ourselves
 the tough questions. Are we majoring in the primary
 purposes? Do we need to recommit ourselves to what is
 truly important? Do we need to cut ties with some things
 which are distracting us from our real purpose?

This is God's church. He purchased it with the blood of
 His Son (Acts 20:28). We should remember that we are
 stewards and will give an account for what we did or
 didn't do (Mt. 25).
