Giving

We live in a time of great need. In these uncertain times, people seek financial assistance for several reasons. In general, there are government assistance programs, charities, and churches lending a helping hand. In the face of expectations to be charitable, the Lord's church ought to seek God's will in giving.

God's word commands the church to take up a collection on the first day of each week (1Cor. 16:2). The collection is to be used *"for the saints"* (1Cor. 16:1). Christians in Judea were experiencing a famine, and the apostle Paul instructs the Gentile congregations to send financial aid to them (Rom. 15:25-27; 2Cor. 9:1-4; Acts 24:17).

A second financial responsibility is *"widows indeed."* A widow who has no family to care for her and who *"has fixed her hope on God and continues in entreaties and prayers night and day"* should be helped by the church (1Tim. 5:4).

A third responsibility of the church is to support those who proclaim the gospel of Jesus Christ. When Jesus went about preaching with the twelve disciples, certain women *"were contributing to their support out of their private means"* (Lk. 8:3). The apostle Paul received financial support from congregations he planted (Phil. 4:15-16). In fact, *"the Lord directed those who proclaim the gospel to get their living from the gospel"* (1Cor. 9:14). This may have included not only local and traveling preachers but also elders (1Tim. 5:17-18).

Let's seek to shine the light of Christ in our generosity. Let's help our fellow believers who have financial emergencies. Let's make sure our widows are cared for. Let's support the preaching and teaching of God's word. Then, let's not forget benevolence to those in the world (Gal. 6:10).
