The Perfect Gift

Finding the “right” gift for each person on my Christmas list is a daunting challenge. A gift card may be the “right” gift for the practical people on my list (and I receive 4x the fuel points). But a thoughtful gift which demonstrates attentiveness and careful consideration increases the recipient's joy.

Unfortunately, much of my gift giving leaves me feeling frustrated and incompetent. Often, I feel exposed for how little I actually know about what makes my friends happy. As time runs out on finding the perfect gift, I find myself burdened by obligation and begrudgingly purchase a “guilt gift.”

Giving to Jesus can be even more exasperating because it's not limited to a few days each year. Sometimes, I wonder if what I'm doing for Him is enough. Am I doing enough good works? Am I putting enough in the collection plate? Am I transforming into His likeness as much and as fast as I should be? My answer to these questions often leaves me feeling depressed.

Then I remember that giving to Jesus is easy. There's no need to search high and low. What He wants us to give Him is our weaknesses, and He gives us His strength in return. He calls to every person: *“Come to Me, all who are weary and heavy-laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy and My burden is light”* (Mt. 11:28-30).
