



PLEASE! I'm begging you. Read God's Word.

Specifically I'm asking you to read through the entire Bible in the year 2018. Zondervan's Bible on CD has a run time of 76 hours. That means that a person can read through the Bible in one year by reading the Bible for 15 minutes each day. What else do you do for at least 15 minutes each day? Watch television? Play a video game? Workout? Talk to friends? Shop? Surf the internet?

The lack of self-discipline and motivation may have prevented you from reading through God's word in the past. Let me suggest a few things to help with the self-discipline. Get a reading schedule (there is one in the main foyer at the church building). The schedule has you read some from the Old Testament and some from the New Testament each day. Simply mark your progress. You can read ahead or if necessary read to catch up. Join me and others in reading through God's word this way. Another alternative is to buy a daily reading Bible, which often presents the Bible chronologically. This may bring together the events, people, and prophecy in a new way for you. Listening to the Bible on CD or MP3 is another possibility.

Motivation is a bit tougher to generate. People don't generally do things unless they see personal value in it, but that's not even a guarantee. There are plenty of people who see the value of eating healthy and exercising regularly but don't do it. So, how can we motivate ourselves to read through the Bible? Consider what it is. It is the word of God. Reading it reveals your Creator's love for you and His plan for your life. Also, consider what is at stake... your eternal destiny.

Of course we don't want to leave the impression that simply reading the Bible is sufficient for understanding and internalizing God's word. It requires study and application and association with God and his people. What I'm saying is that a relationship with God starts with reading His Word.
