An Inadequate View of God

Our perspective of God determines how we conduct ourselves in His presence. Wherever we find an inadequate understanding of God, we will also witness unusual behavior. Adam and Eve thought they could hide from God. Jonah thought he could outrun God, and the Israelites thought they could depict their god in images of wood, stone, and precious metals. Today many unfortunate actions may be traced to a poor understanding of the living God. Ornate cathedrals are built, a hierarchy of clergy is developed, and religious division becomes rampant... all because of a misunderstanding of God.

Some people perceive God as weak. They believe they may live out their lives as they please and He will still welcome them into eternity. Some believe God is too harsh, thinking He demands perfection of us all and hardly anyone will be able to measure up to His standards. The reality of God lies somewhere between these extremes.

Most Christians also struggle with the reality of God. When we decide to do something displeasing to Him, we tend to think of Him as weak and determine that He will allow us the indiscretion. And when we are busy accomplishing good things in His work, we may think that He cannot get along without us.

Since the right perspective leads to a right response, then how should we view God? Maybe the image of a loving Father, so often presented in Scripture, gives us the best perspective. The apostle Paul wrote, *“Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children”* (Eph. 5:1). Yes, we are *“beloved children.”* Children who love their father want to please him in all things. Thus, children have the tendency to look like their father. And Christian children will reflect in their behavior, their own concept of God. People may look at your life and see what you think of God.
