Producing Fruit

Growth is one of the main characteristics of any living organism. Likewise, it is a sign of a healthy Christian. Jesus says that He is the vine and His disciples are branches. When believers are attached to Jesus, they naturally grow... "I am the vine, you are the branches; he who abides in Me and I in him, he bears much fruit, for apart from Me you can do nothing" (John 15:5).

As the year comes to an end, let each one of us examine the spiritual fruit he or she has produced this past year. Let's ask ourselves: "Have I grown fruit such as love, joy, patience, self-control, moral virtue, biblical knowledge, perseverance, or brotherly kindness?"

Jesus says that inspecting our fruit production reveals the truth about our relationship with Him: "Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit, He takes away" and "they gather them, and cast them into the fire and they are burned" (John 15:2,6).

If you and I have not developed the fruit of Jesus in ourselves, we are not alive in Him as we may think. If you find ample fruit inside yourself keep doing what you are doing. However, if you can't find the fruit of Jesus in yourself then make whatever changes are necessary to become a spiritually productive branch.

Do as one might do to a fruit tree... "dig around it and put in fertilizer" (Luke 13:8). This would include things such as prayer, confession of sin, Bible study, Christian fellowship, and serving others.
