A Sure Thing

You can know where you will spend eternity. Jesus knew where he was going after death (Jn. 13:3). The apostle Paul knew where he was going when he died (2 Tim. 4:7-8). When we put our faith in Jesus Christ, hope is *an anchor for the soul, a hope both sure and steadfast...* (Heb. 6:19). Hope is the confident expectation of salvation through faith in Christ. The apostle John explains the certainty of eternity for the children of God... *These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, so that you may know that you have eternal life* (1 Jn. 5:13).

If you believe, repent, and are baptized, you are saved (Mk. 16:16; Acts 2:38). If you are striving against sin by following the example of Christ Jesus, His blood cleanses you from all sin (1 Jn. 1:7). If you confess our sins, he forgives all your sins without exception (1 Jn. 1:7, 9). Jesus Christ, the Son of God, advocates for your salvation and his sacrifice satisfies the anger of God (1 Jn. 2:1-2).

Knowing that you will inherit eternal life should motivate you to keep moving forward and upward. You can have complete confidence in being saved because of God's provision and promise. The apostle John assures you and all believers in Christ that eternal life is a sure thing: *And now, little children, abide in Him, so that when He appears, we may have confidence and not shrink away from Him in shame at His coming* (1 Jn. 2:28).
