Flu Season Is Here

Some of us were raised with parents who made us go to worship assembly and Bible class no matter how sick we may have been. The current generation of parents seem to exercise more caution and keep their children home if they have a runny nose or a cough. As God's family, what do we do when these two schools of thought collide?

We can debate using scriptures. On the one hand it is a sin to forsake the assembling of ourselves together (Heb. 10:25). While on the other hand we are loving one another by choosing not to expose a fellow believer to contagious symptoms which could cause serious health problems (Jn. 13:34).

Our leaders would like to offer some principles to consider, but the final choice is up to you. First, we strongly encourage in person participation in worship assemblies and Bible studies. These are essential for spiritual health. Second, we recognize the real concerns for keeping ourselves and our children safe. These concerns are higher when pre-existing conditions come into the picture and the consequences of an illness are dire. Third, if you or a family member has a symptom which may be contagious such as a fever, vomiting, diarrhea, cough, or sore throat, it is reasonable for you remain at home and worship together as a family or to participate in worship via streaming on Facebook or our website (www.nchoch.net).

As a body of believers, we have differing opinions about what is best to do. Each one of us is doing the best he or she can do to serve the Lord and to be a loving member of God's family. Thank you for having the love and patience of Christ toward each other.
