The Greatest Ruler

Genghis Khan may be considered one of the greatest rulers of all time. His name means "emperor of all men." This Mongolian nomad established laws which demanded obedience to him, unity among the tribes, and heartless punishment of wrongdoers. Under his leadership, wild tribesmen allied to become invincible armies.

Alexander the Great lived only thirty-three years, but his conquest of the known world changed the direction of history. He ushered in a new age and expanded Greek culture and civilization throughout the world. Thus, he could be the greatest ruler of all time.

Even though Joseph Stalin was a ruthless leader, he could be on the list of greatest rulers. Stalin believed that the Soviet Union was between fifty and one hundred years behind modern nations, so he executed plans to close the distance. Through industrialization and modernization, he established the Soviet Union as a major world power.

If power and authority are the measure of greatness, the Lord Jesus Christ must be considered the greatest ruler of all time. In a heavenly revelation the apostle John saw the end of all earthly kingdoms at the hand of Jesus Christ. John wrote of Jesus' domination... "From His mouth comes a sharp sword, so that with it He may strike down the nations, and He will rule them with a rod of iron; and He treads the wine press of the fierce wrath of God, the Almighty. And on His robe and on His thigh He has a name written, 'KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS"" (Rev. 19:15-16).

When we compare the rulers and what they offer, obedience to the Lord is the wisest decision.
