#### Giving

Giving does not come naturally for most of us. Picking out the right gift seems be more and more difficult. In fact, when we talk to others about what we did for Christmas, one of the first questions will be, "What did you **get** for Christmas?" This seems a bit hypocritical since we call it "the season for giving."

Perhaps, looking at God's supreme gift can enlighten our selfish hearts. Jesus said to Nicodemus: "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life" (John 3:16). I see three principles in God's generosity that might help us to be better givers.

- **1. Give out of love.** Love motivated God to give. Give because of your affection for others. This often leads to the most thoughtful and appreciated gifts. Our world has enough stuff. What we need is more love.
- **2. Give of self.** God gave His Son, a part of Himself. This is risky because we are opening ourselves up to rejection, but rewarding because it can result in a relationship.
- **3. Give to benefit of others**. Stop seeking the appreciation of others or their admiration. Think about gifts that will truly benefit a person. God's gift brought eternal life. What can you give to help your loved ones get to heaven?
