All Things Are Possible

When the disciples heard Jesus say that it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for the rich to enter the kingdom of heaven, they envisioned a world in which no can be saved. Jesus looked at them and said: *"With people this is impossible, but with God all things are possible"* (Mt. 19:26).

When Gabriel told Mary that she would give birth to a child who would be the Son of the Most High, sit on the throne of David, and reign without end, she asked him, "How?" Gabriel said, *"Nothing will be impossible with God"* (Lk. 1:37).

People who understand this are unstoppable. Paul suffered greatly—beatings, imprisonment, even being stoned and left for dead. He never quit preaching and teaching the gospel because he believed God can do far more abundantly beyond all that we ask or think (Eph. 3:20). Abraham believed God was able to raise people from the dead, so he obeyed God's command (Heb. 11:19). David faced Goliath believing that all things are possible with God (1Sam. 17:36, 46).

Do you believe the Bible? Do you believe that with God all things are possible? While God may not ask you to fight a giant or sacrifice your child or endure beatings and imprisonment, believing all things are possible with God may help you to rejoice always, pray without ceasing, and give thanks in everything (1 Th. 5:16-18).
