Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, "Speak to Aaron and to his sons, saying, "Thus you shall bless the sons of Israel. You shall say to them:

*The LORD bless you, and keep you;
The LORD make His face shine on you,
And be gracious to you;
The LORD lift up His countenance on you,
And give you peace.'*

So they shall invoke My name on the sons of Israel, and I then will bless them" (Num. 6:22-27).

What a joy to abide under the Divine blessing! This puts a gracious flavour into all things. If we are blessed, then all our possessions and enjoyments are blessed; yea, our losses and crosses, and even our disappointments. God's blessing is deep, emphatic, effectual. A man's blessing may begin and end in words, but the blessing of the Lord makes rich and sanctifies.
