No Knowledge

Cursing, lying, murdering, stealing, and adultery are the kinds of things you might expect from people who don't know any better. However, when it is God's people doing evil things, it's disconcerting. Such was the case in Israel: *"There is swearing, deception, murder, stealing and adultery. They employ violence, so that bloodshed follows bloodshed"* (Hosea 4:2).

God says that this bad behavior is due to a lack of knowledge about right and wrong: *"My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge"* (Hosea 4:6). What makes this circumstance even more incredible is that God's people have chosen to be ignorant. They have the oracles of God, but they have refused to acknowledge them and to live by them (2 Kings 17:13, 14).

Like many church leaders who have gone before, I wonder if we are repeating the same mistake. I wonder if many of us who profess to be followers of Christ have rejected the knowledge which leads us to righteousness.

If we can't answer a few fundamental questions, it seems plausible that we have lost our way. Can we name the 66 books of the Bible? Do we know book, chapter, and verse for what we must do to be saved? Can we recite portions of God's word from memory? Do we know God's names and traits? Do we know what our responsibilities toward each other are?

Knowing what the Bible says does not make one a true follower of Christ. Satan can quote Scripture, and he is not a disciple of Jesus. But, what does it say of us if we lack the knowledge of God's will?

Answer God's call to knowledgeable... *"Now for this very reason also, applying all diligence, in your faith supply moral excellence, and in your moral excellence, knowledge..."* (2 Peter 1:5).
