February 1<sup>st</sup>, we celebrate one-year anniversary serving in Carbon Valley. It's been a busy and blessed year. Thank you for your continued prayers and financial support and for believing in this work. We diligently ask God to send us mature Christians and for truth-seekers who will be receptive to the gospel of Jesus Christ. Our first priority is the growth of God's kingdom.

We are planning a campaign with students from Bear Valley Bible Institute this March. We want to teach a seminar on "How We Got the Bible," and invite the community to attend. We will use the Bear Valley students to distribute door flyers informing the community of the church's presence, worship, Bible study opportunities, and hopefully Bible seminar (we're having trouble securing a location for the seminar).

We continue to hold a Bible study on Thursday nights in our home. Rhianna is planning a Ladies Study to start in February. She is planning to teach through 1 & 2 Peter on Fridays. We are discussing goals and vision that will create a forward-leaning culture where we imagine what kind of a future we want for this work. We are building on our groundwork for a culture of growth, unity, and an identity centered on Jesus and His Word. November attendance average was 20 and December was almost 30. Average monthly contribution was \$930 and \$1226.
