These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, so that you may know that you have eternal life. This is the confidence which we have before Him, that, if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us *in* whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests which we have asked from Him. If anyone sees his brother *or sister* committing a sin not *leading* to death, he shall ask and *God* will, for him, give life to those who commit sin not *leading* to death. There is sin *leading* to death; I am not saying that he should ask about that. All unrighteousness is sin, and there is sin not *leading* to death. We know that no one who has been born of God sins; but He who was born of God keeps him, and the evil one does not touch him. We know that we are of God, and that the whole world lies in *the power of* the evil one. And we know that the Son of God has come, and has given us understanding so that we may know Him who is true; and we are in Him who is true, in His Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God and eternal life. Little children, guard yourselves from idols (1John 5:13-21 NASB).
