Remember Me?

Do you worry about being forgotten? Accomplishments and relationships in the workplace are forgotten shortly after a person retires. Folks who move into assisted living tend to worry about being forgotten by friends and loved ones. When facing death, some of us will worry about being quickly forgotten by family and friends.

Jesus did not directly address our desire to be remembered. However, he did say some things that can be of great comfort.

When Jesus' disciples returned from a short preaching campaign, they were excited because they were more powerful than the demons. The disciples were doing things which were truly memorable. While their work in destroying the power of Satan had great significance, Jesus told them that having one's name recorded in God's book of life far outweighs anything else they might do. He said to them: *"Nevertheless do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rejoice that your names are recorded in heaven"* (Luke 10:20).

On another occasion, Jesus praised loyalty to Him. Even though it may not be considered memorable to humans, it is golden to God. He said: *"Therefore everyone who confesses Me before men, I will also confess him before My Father who is in heaven. But whoever denies Me before men, I will also deny him before My Father who is in heaven"* (Matthew 10:32-33).

It's not a sin to want to be remembered after your death. But, it's more important to be remembered by God. Don't worry about how long the world might remember you. Rather, focus on doing those things for which God will remember you for all eternity... *"He who overcomes will thus be clothed in white garments; and I will not erase his name from the book of life, and I will confess his name before My Father and before His angels"* (Rev. 3:5).
