Ten

God intends to destroy Sodom, and Abraham asks, “*Will you indeed sweep away the righteous with the wicked?*” At first Abraham seems to be pleading with God perhaps for the life of Lot and his family. But, as he probes the mind of God, he discovers a gracious and merciful God who will not destroy an immoral city for the sake of just ten righteous residents (Genesis 18:32). Abraham may have believed that he had just saved Lot and all the people of Sodom from destruction.

The next day brought disappointment. Abraham returned to the place where he had spoken with the LORD and saw smoke like a furnace ascending from the valley cities (Genesis 19:27, 28).

Abraham's worldview changed that day. Seeing that less than ten righteous people remained in Sodom and Gomorrah, he concluded that the fear of the LORD had vanished from the earth. Therefore, he asked Sarah to lie about being his wife because he thought “*surely there is no fear of God in this place*” (Genesis 20:11).

Some of my own experiences have left me wondering if there is anyone who fears God in this place? Cultures have developed as the Spirit told Paul: “*For men will be lovers of self, lovers of money, boastful, arrogant, revilers, disobedient to parents...*” (2 Timothy 3:2). Thus, finding people who are seeking God and are willing to submit to His will seems increasingly rare.

Like Abraham my worldview has grown pessimistic, and I have speculated that there is no fear of God in this place. Then, I remember that Abraham's view led him to lie and to cause others to sin (Genesis 20:2). Abraham forgot that his life depended on God's grace and power. May we always remain optimistic believing that God is powerful and that people can change. Let's not lose hope even if there seems to be fewer than ten righteous people in this place.
