A Tough Christian Principle

Here are some powerful words from the apostle Peter:

"To sum up, let all be harmonious, sympathetic, brotherly, kindhearted, and humble in spirit; not returning evil for evil, or insult for insult, but giving a blessing instead; for you were called for the very purpose that you might inherit a blessing" (1Pet. 3:8-9).

One of the difficult principles of Christianity to follow is the principle of no retaliation. From our youth we have been "getting back" or "getting even" with those who did us wrong, but now we are expected to change all that... "not returning evil for evil, or insult for insult." Truly, compliance with such a concept presents a tremendous challenge.

But, there's even more demanded of us. Peter goes even further to add, "*but giving a blessing instead*." Yipes!!! Not only are we required to withhold our revenge, but we're expected to render good to those that dish out evil to us. Does Peter know what he's saying? Is he in tune with real life? The answer is yes... he fully understands... the Christian life.

Christ showed us the way... first, in His teaching: "....love your enemies, and pray for those who persecute you" (Mt. 5:44); and second, in His example: "...while being reviled, He did not revile in return; while suffering, He uttered no threats, but kept entrusting Himself to Him who judges righteously" (1Pet. 2:23).

Letting go of the retaliating spirit may be difficult, but when you do, you will find that it brings great benefit to your life. Not only will you find happiness now, but ultimately you will receive eternal joy. So, go ahead... find someone to bless.
