Israel

Israel was a person. God changed Jacob's name to Israel (Gen. 32:28; 35:10). God chose Israel to receive the promises of Abraham (Gen. 35:11). The divine Messiah was to become human through the descendants of Israel.

Israel was a nation. Twelve sons were born to Jacob. These sons become the twelve tribes of the nation of Israel. After God redeemed Israel from slavery in Egypt, He gave them His laws and referred to Israel as a nation (Dt. 4:6, 34).

Israel was a place. Under the leadership of Joshua and as God had promised Abraham, the tribes of Israel defeated the Canaanites and took their land (Josh. 1:2; 14:1). On a few occasions, Israel referred to its territory and dominion (1 Sam. 11:3; 2 Kin. 10:32).

According to the new covenant, Israel now refers to God's spiritual people who have a spiritual inheritance (Gal. 3:14, 26), spiritual worship (Jn. 4:21, 23), and a spiritual inheritance (Jn. 17:2). Beware of the false circumcision who continue to put their trust in genealogy and country (Rev. 2:9; 3:9). *"For we are the true circumcision, who worship in the Spirit of God and glory in the Christ Jesus and put no confidence in the flesh"* (Phil. 3:3).
