## **Properly Working**

It's hard to find workers. Businesses can't find reliable laborers because so many people are seeking a paycheck and benefits but are unwilling to do the work. Social clubs encounter the same mindset. People join for the fun and fellowship, but a small percentage actually do the work of organizing, decorating, cooking, and contributing financially.

According to various studies of churches, ten or twenty percent of the people do eighty or ninety percent of the work. The church is not a business nor a social club. Therefore, we should refuse to treat it like one.

**All the saved contribute to the growth of the body of Christ...** *but speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in all aspects into Him who is the head, even Christ, from whom the whole body, being fitted and held together by what every joint supplies, according to the proper working of each individual part, causes the growth of the body for the building up of itself in love (Eph. 4:15, 16).*
